

Transcript for video tutorial on Group choice activity

In this video, you will learn how to use group choice function on Moodle.

Group choice allows students to enroll themselves to a group created by the teacher.

Teachers can limit the number of students in each group.

In the course homepage, click "Turn editing on" button to enable the editing mode.

Go to the topic where you would like to create the group choice.

Click "Add an activity or resource".

Select "Group choice".

Click "Add" button.

Fill in the general information in this page including the group choice name and the introduction text.

For the item "Allow choice to be updated", students can update their choices if teachers select "Yes" here.

For the item "Limit the number of response allowed", teacher can limit the number of participants that select each group choice option by enable this function.

Teachers can select the group and set the limit of responses here.

For the item "Restrict answering to the time period", students can make their choices within the time period by enable this function.

After you completed filling all those information, you can click "Save and return to course".

Students can select the group by selecting the radio button.
