

Transcript for video tutorial on Turnitin Assignment activity

In this video, you will learn how to add a turnitin assignment.

In the course homepage, click "Turn editing on" button to enable the editing mode.

Go to the topic where you want to create the assignment.

Select "Turnitin Assignment".

Fill in the general information about the turnitin assignment including "assignment name" and "summary".

For the submission type, if you would like students upload file for the assignment, we can just keep the default setting "File upload".

For the item "Student originality report", we can select "Yes", so that students can view their own originality report.

For the item, report generation speed, there are 3 options,

generate reports immediately, first report is final means students cannot resubmit the papers, the report will be generated immediately after students submitted their papers.

Generate reports immediately, reports can be written until due date, means the report is generated immediately.

Students are allowed to resubmit the papers before the due date.

Generate reports on due date, means the submissions are generated on the due date.

Resubmissions are allowed before the due date.

I choose the second option "Generate reports immediately, reports can be written until due date" here.

Teachers can set the checking criterias accordingly here.

After you completed filling all those information, you can click "Save and display" button to set the submission date of the assignment.

Click the edit icon to set the start date, due date and post date of the assignment.

Start date is the date that students can start to upload assignment.

Students can view their grades and feedbacks of this assignment after the post date.

After setting the dates, click "Submit".

Teachers can view the submissions by clicking "Submission Inbox".
